This Friday is Cuddle up and Read day in First Grade! Wear your pajamas and slippers to school. Don't forget to bring your favorite book and stuffed animal!

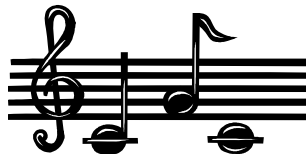


Winter Wonderland Day
